Pupil Premium Allocation 2015 - 2016

The 'Pupil Premium' was introduced in April 2011. The Government provides additional funding for certain groups of pupils: those who are eligible for Free School Meals (FSM), children who are looked after and pupils whose parents are in the armed forces. This includes pupils who have been eligible for FSM within the past 6 years (FSM Ever 6).

"It is for schools to decide how the Pupil Premium...is spent, since they are best placed to assess what additional provision should be made for the individual pupils within their responsibility." Source DfE website.

For the year 2015-2016, Kings Caple Primary Academy has been allocated £7,920 to spend on initiatives to ensure that these children reach their full potential - academically, socially, emotionally and behaviourally.

For this academic year we are allocating the money in the following way:

- Subsidised school trips, including swimming and educational visits;
- Shakespeare Festival Project;
- Thrass Training;
- Thrass Resources;
- Talk4Writing Training
- Teacher and TA based intervention work.

Kings Caple Primary Academy have 44 pupils on role (Spring 2015). In order to comply with the Data Protection Act 1998 the number of pupils in receipt of PP is not listed here.
