

Kings Cagle Primary Academy **Pupil Premium Allocation 2014 - 2015**

The 'Pupil Premium' was introduced in April 2011. The Government provides additional funding for certain groups of pupils: those who are eligible for Free School Meals (FSM), children who are looked after and pupils whose parents are in the armed forces. This includes pupils who have been eligible for FSM within the past 6 years (FSM Ever 6).

"It is for schools to decide how the Pupil Premium...is spent, since they are best placed to assess what additional provision should be made for the individual pupils within their responsibility." Source DfE website.

For the year 2014-2015, Kings Cagle Primary Academy has been allocated £7,800 + £900 Service Children to spend on initiatives to ensure that these children reach their full potential - academically, socially, emotionally and behaviourally.

For this academic year we are allocating the money in the following way:

- Subsidised school trips, including swimming, educational visits and extra-curricular activities
- 1:1 topic based topic work tuition including additional resources
- TA support and intervention groups for literacy and numeracy.
- Adult led activity based intervention, focussing on developing social and emotional understanding including additional resources.

Kings Cagle Primary Academy have 41 pupils on role (Autumn 2014). In order to comply with the Data Protection Act 1998 the number of pupils in receipt of PP is not listed here.
