

English

This term we will be writing reviews; focussing on books and films.
We will be looking at and creating information texts based around the history of film.
We will also be looking at poetry through the medium of writing song lyrics.
Finally, we will be writing a story which the children will then create and film a trailer for. Look out for the red carpet screening!

Mathematics

We will continue with daily basic skills maths, focussing on the key areas of four rules, balancing the equals, doubling and halving, number bonds and place value.
We will also look at measure, shape and space, basic arithmetic as well as applying knowledge in reasoning activities.

Science

This term we will be looking at sound and electricity. We will focus on how sounds is made, the impact of distance on sound and how to change sounds.
With electricity we will be drawing and constructing circuits as well as looking at conductors and insulators.

Art and Design

We will be looking at and creating: album covers, film posters, book covers.
We will design and make items for our stop frame animation.
We will design and make musical instruments and will be doing portraits of famous musicians.
