

English

During the Summer term we will be continuing to increase our writing stamina. We will look at writing a story using a starter, build up, dilemma, resolution and ending to structure our story. In addition to our creative writing we will focus on non-fiction writing including diary entries and factual writing. We will look at up-levelling our vocabulary choice and editing our own work to recognise how we can independently improve our writing across subjects.

Topic

Whilst looking at 'Coastlines' we will look at learning and using our geographical skills to understand what has happened and is continuing to happen to coastlines around the world. We will look at the impact weathering and erosion has had on coastlines. In addition to this we will make predictions about the future of our Earth and what we can do to preserve our world.

MFL

French will be our focus as a whole school. We will learn to converse and write phrases related to our interests.

Art

We will link our topic of coastlines by looking at the seaside for inspiration using different media to create seaside scenes and sea creatures.

Design & Technology

We will look at where our food comes from and designing nutritious

Computing

In Computing this term we will be focusing on Online Safety. We will look at our relationship with technology and how that influences our feelings, as well as keeping safe whilst playing on games.

Mathematics

Class 3 children will be looking at the properties of shapes during their Mathematics lessons. They will be looking into angles and learning to use protractors. We will also look at 3D shapes and the different nets for these shapes. On top of this we will be consolidating the Maths we have learnt throughout the year as well as ensuring our basic skills knowledge is secure to help us in our reasoning.

Coastlines

Physical Education

In our PE session we will be reminding ourselves of the rules of rounders and how to play in a team. We will also focus on our athletics skills such as sprinting, running over a range of distances, hurdling and throwing a range of objects.

Religious Education

This term we will be looking at why the Torah is so important to Jewish people. We will also look at what matters most to Humanists and Christians.

Science

The children will be investigating Space this term. We will learn about our Solar System and the connection between Earth, the sun, moon and other planets. In addition to this we will be looking at how the eye works to interpret light. We will learn how light travels in a straight line and how shadows are cast as a result.

PSHE

As part of our topic this term the children will look at their relationships - and specifically how this is impacted by technology in modern lives. We will also be looking at 'Changing Me' focusing on self image, puberty and conception.

Music

We will be learning to harmonise when singing and performing during our music sessions, as well as creating our own pieces to perform.
