Mathematics

In Maths this term, Class 2 will be learning about fractions and decimals, in line with the National Curriculum. The children will also continue to develop fluency in their times tables, which will support their learning across the maths curriculum and help build confidence in problem-solving. We will move onto perimeter and area at the end of the term.

Science

In Science this term, Class 2 will be learning about Earth and Space. The children will explore the planets in our solar system, the movement of the Earth and Moon, and how these affect day and night, developing their understanding of the world beyond our planet.

Geography and History

This spring term, Class 2 will be learning all about the Tudors. We will be exploring the key question *"What was life like in Tudor England?"* and finding out about daily life, homes, food and important people from this fascinating period in history.

Art and Design

In Art this term, Class 2 will be focusing on 3D sculpture. They will work on creating an interactive installation, developing their skills in shaping, joining, and arranging materials to produce a collaborative piece.
